B. "They built the wall until <b>h</b> the height thereof" (Neh 4:6).
. CHALLENGES AROSE ABOUT HALF WAY THROUGH THE PROJECT.
A. Opposition and d arose.
1. "They all conspired to fight against Jerusalem" (Neh 4:7-8).
2. "The strength of the bearers of burdens is decayed" (Neh 4:10).
B. How did Nehemiah respond to their enemies (Neh 4:9)?
1. With <b>p</b> "We made our prayer unto God."
2. We "set a watch against them day and night."
II. WHY WERE THE PEOPLE DISCOURAGED?
A. The people were <i>exhausted</i> and nowhere close to completion.
B. They were filled with <b>f</b> and panic (4:10, 12).
III. WHAT WAS THE PROBLEM AND SOLUTION?
A. Inappropriate fear. They forgot G and listened to their critics
B. Inadequate faith. They forgot this wall was for God!
C. What did Nehemiah do to bring about a solution?
1. He put their focus on God and His power (Neh 4:14).
2. He concentrated their fortifications (Neh 4:16).
3. He challenged their <b>f</b> (Neh 4:14).
4. He validated their <b>f</b> (Neh 4:19).
