What is of first importance?

“Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures” (1 Cor 15:3-4).



The Importance of Sunday

- We remember the Lord's death on the day he *conquered* death.
- Sunday – *resurrection* day!
- Sunday – The *Lord's* day.




What about Saturday?

- Saturday – *Sabbath day.*
- Saturday – *Day of O.T. Worship.*
 - Commemorated the Exodus!
 - First day of rest from bondage (Deut 5:14-15).


Sabbath (OT) & Sunday (NT) are *similar*

- Sabbath was a *release* from *physical bondage*.
- Sunday is a release from *spiritual* bondage. (*bondage of sin and death*) (Rm 6:23, I Cor 15:54-57)!



The Resurrection is the Foundation of the Christian faith

- If Christ has not been raised, then our **preaching is vain**, your **faith also is vain**. 16 For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised; 17 and if Christ has not been raised, **your faith is worthless**; you are still in your sins (1 Cor 15:14,17). NASU

Participatory Worship/Teaching

- **National Commitment to the Covenant**

 - “You stand before God with your elders and officers, the men of Israel, with your **little ones, with your wives** . . .that you may enter into a covenant with the Lord your God” (Deut 29:10-11).

Participatory Worship/Teaching

- Read and Response in the Psalms
