B. The early Christians had no official annual Easter celebration.
C. Every Sunday was to be special. They had a <b>w</b> celebration!
I. THE IMPORTANCE OF SUNDAY.
A. We remember His death on Sunday, the day he conquered death!
B. Each Lord's day (Rev 1:10), with Sunday communion, we have a complete <b>g</b> (I Cor 15: 1-3).
C. Sunday became the new day of <b>w</b> The Lord's Day!
1. The Sabbath commemorated the <b>e</b> (Deut 5: 14-15).
2. Sunday commemorates the resurrection and promises us our way out of the bondage of death (Rom 6:23, I Cor 15: 54-57).
D. The resurrection is the foundation of the Christian faith (I Cor 15).

A. John reveals: "Then I saw a new <b>h</b> and a new earth" (Rev 21:1).
B. "He will wipe every <b>t</b> from their eyes. There will be no more death, or mourning, or pain" (Rev 21:4).
C. It's Friday, but Sunday's coming must include it is Sunday, but Jesus is coming <i>again</i> !
