## INTRO.

Gen 10 is a selective and accurate *representative* list of nations. God gives us vitally important lessons which are important for today.

#### I. I AM THE FATHER OF ALL MEN.

A. As diverse as each limb appears, we are still branches of the same tree and share the same trunk.
B. All people on earth are of one b\_\_\_\_\_ and essentially the same!
C. What matters most is that we have the same God-stamped image (Gen 1:26).
D. Human solidarity rooted in the F\_\_\_\_\_ of God is the basis for:

Inherent human dignity and intrinsic worth.
Civil rights. Racial slurs are insults to our f\_\_\_\_\_.

E. How far will you go back in your identity? Will you go back to your branch, your trunk, your roots, or the One who planted the seed?

## II. I AM RULER OF ALL NATIONS.

- A. God is a *borderless* God; he is **s**\_\_\_\_\_ over all (Deut 32:8).
- B. Nimrod's "kingdom" eventually becomes the empires of Assyria and Babylon; yet this "rebel's" kingdoms will not last.

## III. I AM SAVIOR OF THE WHOLE WORLD.

- A. The table of nations sets the stage for the call of A who will "bless all the nations of the earth" (Gen 12:1-3, Ex 19: 5-6).
- B. The seventy nations parallel the s\_\_\_\_\_ sent forth in the limited commission. Perhaps it was done to show the worldwide missionary thrust of the gospel (Lk 10:1).
- C. Jesus commanded: "Go and teach all **n**\_\_\_\_\_" (Matt 28:18-20).

#### CON:

- A. God does not save nations, but individual souls, with names like you and me. "I have written your name on the palms of My hands" (Isa 49:16).
- B. Are you ready to have your **n**\_\_\_\_\_ written in the book of life?
