- B. “My loving-kindness will not be removed from you” (Isa 54:10).

IV. GOD’S LOVE IS HIGH ENOUGH TO COVER EVERYTHING.

- A. “Thy sins will I **r**_____ no more” (Jer 31:34).
- B. He will “cast our sins into the depths of the sea” (Mic 7:19).

V. GOD’S LOVE IS DEEP ENOUGH TO BE EVERYWHERE!

- A. “There is no **p**_____ so deep, that God’s love is not deeper.”
- B. “God brought me up out of the pit of destruction (Ps 40: 1-2).
