Practical applications



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- **EXAMPLE OF JESUS** Jn 13:1-20
 - DIVINE PRINCIPLE: “Honor Others Above Ourselves.”
 - HUMAN PRINCIPLE: “Honor Self Above Others.” Matt 23:5-12
 - Key: Avoid Honor Seeking.

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- **DYNAMIC EX. OF PAUL**

– ***“Do nothing out of selfish ambitions.” Phil 2:3***

– ***“Have this mind in you which was also in Christ Jesus.”***

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- **PRACTICAL STEPS FOR**
APPLYING THE PRINCIPLE

–Evaluate your attitudes:

- *In how many situations have you purposely attempted to honor someone else?*

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- *Or expressed sincere appreciation?*
- *Do you ever use this as a selfish technique?*
- **IS IT DIFFICULT FOR YOU TO COMPLIMENT OTHERS?**

- **PRACTICE GOOD MANNERS.**
- **BE ATTENTIVE IN THE “LITTLE THINGS.”**
