Intro

A. “Be **d**_____ to one another in brotherly love, in honor preferring one another” (Rm 12:10).

B. This is a key principle in spiritual interpersonal relationships!

1. Be humble. “Do not seek the chief seats” (Matt 23:8-12).

2. Jesus admonished: “Call no man **f**_____.”

A. “Do nothing out of selfish ambition” (Phil 2:3).

B. “Have this **m**_____ in you which is also in Christ (Phil 2:5).

B. **Perfer “one another”** – choose each others company!

C. Be **a**_____ to each other and practice good manners.

D. **Honor each other** through the “little things,” that can often make a difference!
