- **WHY** is Rahab so important?
 - Our *past sins* will not *disqualify* us from being *accepted* by God!
 - *Rahab was not beyond rehab!*
 - *She is the mother of all faithful Gentiles (Jas 2).*

THE EXALTED PLACE OF RAHAB.

- Rahab's name appears in the family of the Son of God!
 - She is one of only **four women!**
 - *Rahab, Bathsheba, Tamar & Mary.*
 - *Why?*
