I. WHO WAS RAHAB?

- A. She was a Gentile and a woman.
- B. She was a heroine, a survivor and a savior.
- C. She became a proselyte and was grafted into the Hebrews.
- D. She became a faithful **m**_____ to faithful children.
- E. Five times the Bible tells us she was a harlot (Heb 11:31).

II. WHAT MADE HER SO UNIQUE? Her Faith!

- A. "The Lord is your God. He is God in **h**_____ and on earth beneath (Josh 2: 9-11).
- B. "The eyes of the Lord move to and fro... that He may strongly support those whose heart is completely His" (2 Chron 16:9).
- C. "Because thou hast seen me, ye believed. **B**_____ are they who have not seen, yet believe (John 20:28)!"
- D. "Rahab the harlot was justified by works" (James 2: 25-26).

III. WHY IS RAHAB SO IMPORTANT?

- A. She shows us that our *past sins* will not disqualify us.

IV. HOW WAS REHAB SAVED?
