- B. Everyone gets a gift! Know your land and inherit it (I Cor 12:7).

- A. We must make a careful exploration of it (Gal 6:4-5).
- B. There are 14 gifts today (Romans 12, I Cor 12, Eph 4, I Peter 4).

IV. WHAT PITFALLS MUST BE AVOIDED?

- A. Using God’s gifts for worldly **s**_____ (Josh 17:12).
- B. Comparing and competing with others (Gal 6:4-5).
- C. Becoming lazy and not intentionally receiving our gifts!
 - 1. “**S**____ up the gift within you” (2 Tim 1:6).
 - 2. “How long will you neglect to go and possess the land” (Josh 18:3)?
