#### **Introduction:**

A. You are "knit together, woven together in the womb" (Ps 139: 13).B. The Spirit has given each of us a special way of serving others (I Cor 12:7).

#### I. UNIQUENESS IS A MAJOR THEME IN THE BIBLE AND IN JOSHUA.

- A. "For we are his **w**\_\_\_\_\_, created in Christ Jesus" (Eph 2:10).
- B. "It is He who forms the hearts of all" (Ps 33:15).
- C. Joshua 13-22 deals with the distribution of the l\_\_\_\_\_.
- D. The inheritance was for **e**\_\_\_\_\_ but the assignments were *individual*. No one gets everything, but everyone gets something.

#### **II. WHAT IS THE APPLICATION FOR THE CHURCH TODAY?**

- A. Jesus, "when He ascended to the heights, he led a crowd of captives and gave **g**\_\_\_\_\_\_ to His people" (Eph 4:7-8).
- B. Everyone gets a gift! Know your land and inherit it (I Cor 12:7).

### **III. HOW DO WE DISCOVER OUR OWN GIFTS?**

- A. We must make a careful exploration of it (Gal 6:4-5).
- B. There are 14 gifts today (Romans 12, I Cor 12, Eph 4, I Peter 4).

#### **IV. WHAT PITFALLS MUST BE AVOIDED?**

- A. Using God's gifts for worldy **s**\_\_\_\_\_ (Josh 17:12).
- B. Comparing and competing with others (Gal 6:4-5).
- C. Becoming lazy and not intentionally receiving our gifts!
  - 1. "**S**\_\_\_\_\_ up the gift within you" (2 Tim 1:6).
  - 2. "How long will you neglect to go and possess the land" (Josh 18:3)?
