- A. Webster: “To admit a fault or debt one has committed.”
- B. Literally: “To say along with.”
- C. “If you confess with your **m**_____ Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved” (Rom 10:9).

II. A KEY PREREQUISITE TO CONFESSION IS HUMILITY.

- A. One can’t sincerely praise God without being made humble.
- B. “Humble yourselves and God will **l**_____ you up (Jas 4:10).
- C. “He forgets not the cry of the **h**_____” (Ps 9:12).
- D. The publican went away justified and the Pharisee did not (Lk 18:10-14).
- E. Nehemiah is a great example of a humble prayer of confession (Neh 1:4-7).

III. WHAT HAPPENS WHEN WE REFUSE TO CONFESS?

- A. “He that turns away his ear from hearing the law, his prayer shall be an abomination (Prov 28:9).
