HOW TO PRAY?

Use A-C-T-S

- A DORATION (*the upward look*)
- C ONFESSION (*the inward look*)
- T HANKSGIVING (*the roundward look*)
- S UPPLICATION (*the outward look*).

Remember these scriptures as you pray:

Matt 7:7 – “Ask and it shall be given unto you, seek and ye shall find, knock and it shall be opened unto you.”

Jn 15:7 – “If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatsoever you will, and it shall be done unto you.”

Jas 1:6-7 – “If any of you lacketh wisdom, let him ask of God, who giveth to all liberally...and it shall be given unto him. But let him ask in faith, nothing doubting, for he that doubteth is like the surge of the sea driven by the wind and tossed. For let not that man thinketh he shall receive anything of the Lord.”

1 Jn 5:14-15 – “this is the boldness which we have toward Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He heareth us; and if we know that He heareth us whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions which we have asked of Him.”


Jas 4:2 – “ye have not because ye ask not. Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask with selfish motives, that ye might spend it simply on your own pleasures.”

Think about the Angels!

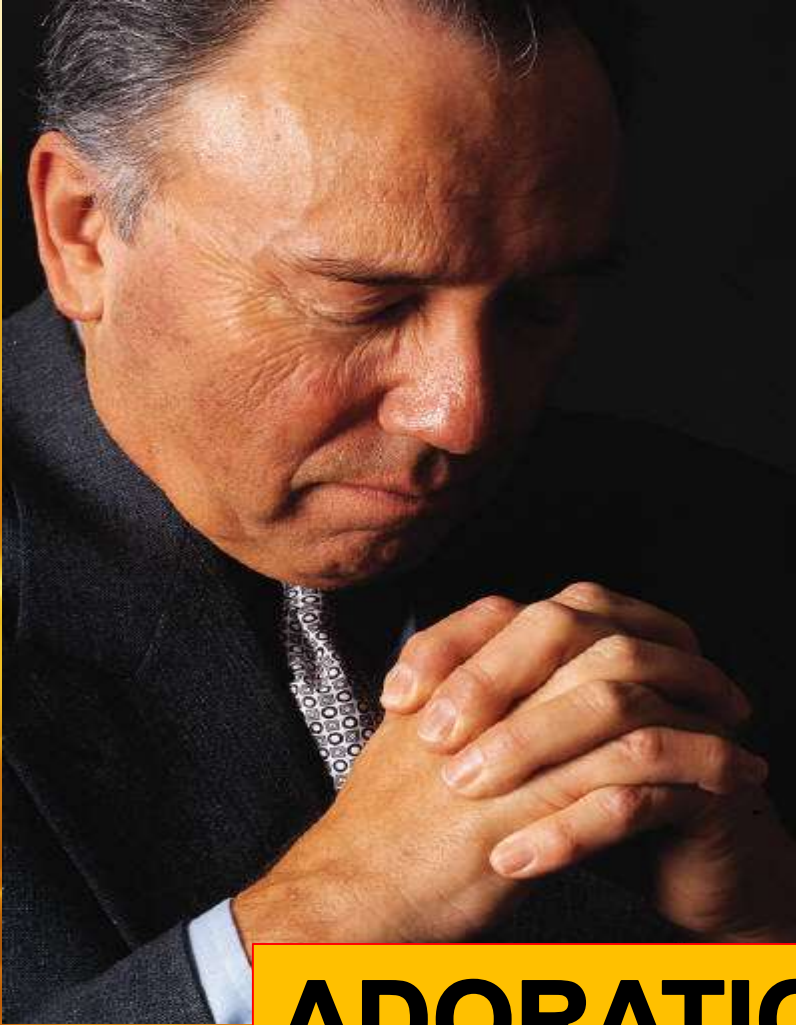
(Rev 4-5)

Magnify His Name = Magnify God!

- Vary how you address God and study His names in Scripture!
 - Heb for name = “individual mark”
 - Gk for name = “To know.”
- A good understanding of the *names of God* leads to a better understanding of God Himself!

“Hallowed be Your Name”

- Elohim – “Eternally Powerful One” (Gen 1:1-2).
- El-Shaddai – “All-sufficient One” (Gen 17:1).
- El-Elyon – “Most High God.”
- El-Olam – “The Everlasting God” (Gen 21:33).

Jehovah (Lord) & Derivatives

- **Jehovah** – “Great I AM.”
- “The Lord our Righteousness.”
- “The Lord who will Provide.”
- “The Lord who Heals you!”
- “The Lord is my Banner”
- My shepherd, our peace, is there!

My Favorite Names for God

- Abba –Mark 14:36
- Defender of widows – Ps 68:5
- Father to the fatherless – Ps 68:5
- God of all comfort – 2 Cor 1:3
- Living God! – Ps 42:2
- One who remembered us – Ps 136:23 & hears prayer-Ps 65:2

Remember Rm 8:26-27

- “The Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.”



ADORATION IN PRAYER

Suggestions:

- **Get into the Psalms.**
 - Prayers you can make your own!
 - Ps 34:3 “O magnify the LORD with me, And let us exalt His name together.”

ADORATION IN PRAYER

Ps 25:1-5

“To you O Lord I do lift up my soul. It is only in You that I trust. I believe what Your Word says, that ‘No one whose hope is in you will ever be put to shame.’ Please show me Your ways and teach me your paths. Give me the strength and courage to be obedient. You are my hope, today and tomorrow. In you and you alone do I trust!”

Study/Memorize Praise Passages


- I Tim 6:15-16 “Blessed is the King of Kings, Lord of Lords, who is the *immortal God*, that dwells in *light unapproachable*.”

ADORATION IN PRAYER

Use language of praise from your favorite songs!
