Romantic Love Not something *we choose*, just *happens*.

Love as an "Attitude."

- Jn 3:16 "God so loved..."
- We <u>choose</u> this kind of love.
 - Matt 5:44-45 *"love* your enemies and pray for those who persecute you."



Divine Agape Love . . . An Act of the Will "Let the older women admonish the young women to love their husbands, to love their children..." (Titus 2: 4-5).



How often do you say "I love you?"







Key: Find out what the other person likes ... not what you like!



Key: Needs to be thoughtful, not necessarily expensive.



Key: Especially meaningful when the giver sacrifices in order to provide for the need of the recipient.

Key: Doing for the other person things they would like to have done.





Key: Some show their love for others by doing things for them!

Key: Sometimes you feel overwhelmed and appreciate the help.


The Five Love Languages CS Lewis: "No time spent with a child is ever wasted."

If you need a hug and your loved ones are "clueless" give them permission by issuing them a "Hug License."





Emotional Warmth Can be Reborn! Meaningful Connections are reestablished

Principles on How to Use The Key: Find the primary language

- Ask your spouse! Believe them!
- What if not sure?
 - What is the first thing you do when you want to express love?
 - What is the one thing that hurts you most deeply?
 - Take the questionnaires five love languages & touch/verbal/task
