

Condition's Amos Faced


- Material Prosperity
 - -Amos 3:15 "I will also smite the winter house together with the summer house."

Conditions Amos Faced

- Moral Decadence
 - -2:6-7 "For three transgressions of Israel and for four I will not revoke its punishment, because they sell the righteous for money and the needy for a pair of sandals.
 - –And a <u>man and his father</u> resort to the same girl in order to profane My holy name. NASU

- Continuous Religious Apostasy
 - -Calf-worship 3:14



Formalistic Ritualism


 Amos 5:21-24 "I hate, I reject your festivals, Nor do I delight in your solemn assemblies."

- Prideful and Arrogant Attitude
 - -Amos 6:1 Woe to those who are at ease in Zion, And to those who feel secure in the mountain of Samaria.

OUTLINE

- Amos 1-2 Condemns all the nations around Israel, then points to Israel itself.
- Amos 3-6 Sermon to Israel.
 - Reminds them of sinfulness, violated covenant
 - You will be taken into captivity!
- Amos 7-9 FIVE VISIONS
 - Shows total destruction/punishment to come

Amos 8:2 "What do you see, Amos?" And I said, "A basket of summer fruit." Then the LORD said to me, "The end has come for My people Israel. I will spare them no longer".

The Age of Written Prophecy

- OT Historians of Israelite History
- Make sure the people understood what was happening!
- Do not doubt God's faithfulness!

Basic Message:

- You will be taken into Captivity
 - –NOT because God has lost His power!
 - –NOT because Assyria is so powerful!
 - -BECAUSE OF YOUR SINS!

The Judgment of Jehovah Isaiah 10:5-7

 Woe to Assyria, the rod of My anger and the staff in whose hands is My indignation, I send it against a godless nation, and commission it against the people of My fury to capture booty and to seize plunder, Yet it does not so intend, nor does it plan so in its heart, but rather it is its purpose to destroy and to cut off many nations.

The Judgment of Jehovah

- The curses of the covenant (Deut 28) were promised by God.
- Would serve "as a sign and for a wonder, upon they seed forever" (Deut 28:46)
- LESSON: God is true to His word and there are consequences for breaking His laws!

Four Characteristics:

- It was irrevocable
 - -Could repent individually.
 - -"Seek ye Me, and ye shall live"(5:4)
 - –Too late to avoid national judgment
 - 4: 6-12 List calamities.....
 - 4:11 "Ye have not returned to me."
 - 4:12 "Prepare to meet thy God."

Prepare to Meet Thy God

- Not: Repent before its too late!
- Judgment is coming: Brace yourself!
- Verdict has been sealed!



Four Characteristics

Judgment was deserved.



A Vision of the Plumb line!

A Plumb line



 "A weight with a pointed tip on the bottom that is suspended from a string and used as a vertical reference line."

This <u>instrument</u> has been used since the time of the ancient <u>Egyptians</u> by bricklayers, <u>masons</u>, and carpenters to ensure that their constructions are "plumb", or perfectly upright.

Amos 7: 7-9

"Thus He showed me, and behold, the Lord was standing by a vertical wall with a plumb line in His hand. 8 The LORD said to me, " "What do you see, Amos?" And I said, "A plumb line." Then the Lord said, "Behold I am about to put a plumb line in the midst of My people Israel. I will spare them no longer. 9 "The high places of Isaac will be desolated, and the sanctuaries of Israel laid waste."


Vision of the Plumb line



- Wall = Israel
- Plumb line = God's standard
- God had made Israel upright!
- Slightly crooked repaired.
- Only solution: Tear down!

Judgment would be Severe

- Punishment fits the crime!
 - Amos 2:13-15 "I will press you…"
 - -Amos 3:12 "Just as the shepherd snatches from the lion's mouth two legs or a piece of an ear, so will the sons of Israel dwelling in Samaria be snatched away."



Judgement would be Severe


- Amos 4:2 "The Lord Jehovah hath sworn by his holiness, they shall come and they shall take you away with hooks, and your residue with fish hooks."



Judgment was Unexpected



- Israel's primary enemy = Syria
 - -II Kings 13:7 "Trampled under foot like the dust on threshing floor."



Amos warns:

Amos 5:27 "Therefore, I will make you go into exile beyond Damascus," says the LORD . . .



Assyria first world empire . .

- Impact and bother Israel and Judah
- First to attempt to destroy "nationalism" by deporting people
- Most barbaric (fish hooks)!
 - Intermarry and lose ethnic identity
 - –Lose mother tongue (Hebrew).
 - -Create a half-breed race—Samaritans.



Vision of the Plumb line



- Amos spoke plainly ignored!
- Took bitter pill of captivity/destruction to humble the people.
- Where is America?
- Individually: "Seek the Lord" ... "saved by Him."
