What Motivates Us?

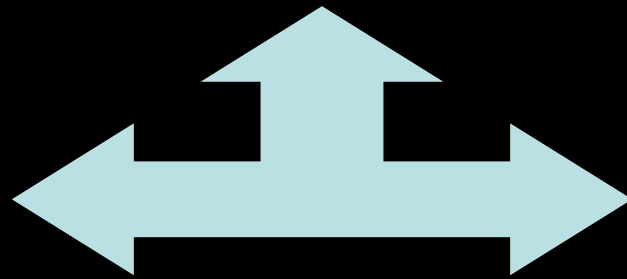
Rt. of Motivation = Motive.

 - Lit: “To move out.”
 - Webster: “That which causes us to act.”

SCRIPTURAL MOTIVATORS

Scriptural Motivators

- **Hope** – “Desire plus expectation.”
 - “I live in hope of eternal life” (Titus 1:1).
 - “... heirs according to the hope of eternal life” (Titus 3:7).



SCRIPTURAL MOTIVATORS

Scriptural Motivators

- **Praise of God vs. Praise of Men** –
 - “Let **God be true**, and every man be a liar” (Rm 3:4).
 - .. “abound more and more, just as you received from us how you **ought to walk and to please God**” (I Thess 4:1).
 - *“Character is what you do when no one is watching.”*

SCRIPTURAL MOTIVATORS

Scriptural Motivators

- **Praise of God vs. Praises of Men**

“But because of the Pharisees, they would not confess Him for fear they would be put out of the synagogue; for they loved praise from men more than praise from God” (Jn 12:42-43).



SCRIPTURAL MOTIVATORS

Scriptural Motivators

- **Sense of Duty** – “Obligation.”
 - We should have a sense of **responsibility** (Prov 22:29).
 - But duty alone, leaves us “**unprofitable servants**” (Lk 17:10).
 - Implication: *“If it were not my duty, I would not do it.”*



SCRIPTURAL MOTIVATORS

Scriptural Motivators

- **Fear** –

- “Some are saved by fear” (Jude 23).
- “Noah was moved with fear” (Heb 11:7).
- “**Fear not** him who is able to destroy the body, but **fear him** who is able to cast body and soul in **hell**” (Matt 10:28).



SCRIPTURAL MOTIVATORS

Scriptural Motivators

- Jesus made 1850 statements about judgment & hell.
- Thirteen percent of His recorded words!



SCRIPTURAL MOTIVATORS

Scriptural Motivators

- **Fear alone, does not usually last!**
 - Can become *immune* to it.
 - It does have its **purpose!**
- “The **fear of the Lord** is the beginning of knowledge” (Prov 1:7).
- It drives you to the side of the Father!
- “No **fear** in love” (I Jn 4:18).

SCRIPTURAL MOTIVATORS

Scriptural Motivators

- **Love** –

- I Cor 13:8 “**Love never fails.**”

- I Jn 4:18 “**Perfect love casts out fear.**”

- Rm 2:4, Ps 116:12, Jn 13:34, Rm 13:8, Rm 15:1-3, I Cor 9:22, Rm 9:3.
