A. Jesus says: "Blessed are the **p**______ in heart" (Matt 5:8). NOTES B. God sees not as man sees... the Lord looks at the heart (I Sam 16:7). **I. THE IMPORTANCE OF MOTIVE** A. God says our *motive* determines whether our **g**_____ deeds are acceptable to Him or not (Matt 6, I Cor 13). B. In human relationships it determines whether bad deeds are *tolerable*. Did you intend to hurt or was it an accident? **II. THE DEFINITION OF MOTIVE** A. The Greek word has the same root as the word *emotion*. B. Literally means: "*That which c*_____ *us to act.*" III. WHAT JESUS IS AND IS NOT TEACHING IN MATTHEW 6. A. Jesus is not warning about idleness, overly aggressive discipleship, or others seeing your good works (Matt 5:16, I Pet 1:3). B. Jesus is warning about **m** 1. "Beware of practicing your righteousness before men to *be noticed* by them, otherwise you have **n** reward" (Matt 6:1). 2. Key: The motive determines the quality of the deed. **IV. PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS: (Keep your heart with diligence)** A.
