- A. God has equipped us with all we need for *spiritual* victory.
- B. There are five things we must do to prepare for the coming battles.

I. BE STRONG IN THE LORD AND HIS STRENGTH (Eph 6:10).

- A. The Lord is **f**_____ (2 Thess 3:1-2).
- B. Paul said: "May the power of Christ rest upon me (2 Cor 12:9-10)."

II. PUT ON THE WHOLE PANOPLY OF GOD (Eph 6:11).

- A. We must choose to "put on the armor" (Rm 13:12).
- B. Five of six pieces are **d**_____, only one is offensive (Eph 6:17)
- C. There is nothing on the back. No provision made for retreat!
- D. We must be careful and **s**_____ as we face Satan (I Peter 5:8).

III. WESTLE AGAINST THE HOSTS OF EVIL (Eph 6:12).

- A. This is *personal*. Hand to hand combat similar to Jacob in Gen 32.
- B. The lance and **s**_____ are missing. Not used in our warfare.
- IV. WE MUST BE COURAGEOUS AND STAND (Eph 6:13).

V. WE MUST REMEMBER WE ARE TO WORK TOGETHER (Eph 6:16).

- A. The rectangular shield was designed to be used with others. The Romans made a formation with their shields known as the t_____.
- B. We are commanded to make **s**______ for all the saints (Eph 6:18).
