### Introduction:

- A. “Adorn yourself in modest apparel” (I Tim 2:9).
- B. “Adorn yourself with that which is proper for women professing g\_\_\_\_\_, with good works” (I Tim 2:10).

### I. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- A. **Modest:** “Well-arranged; orderly, d\_\_\_\_\_.”
- B. **Shamefacedness:** “A sense of shame, a r\_\_\_\_\_ that restrains one from an unworthy act.”
- C. **Sobriety** = “Soundness of mind, self-control, good judgment, moderation, as a feminine virtue, decency.”
- D. **Lasciviousness:** “Lustful, indecent bodily movements, unchaste handling of males and females.”
- E. **Immodest Apparel:** “Any clothing that unduly reveals the f\_\_\_\_\_ of the wearer.”

### II. GUIDELINES FOR MODESTY

- A. “Dress so that you will not tempt a good man and will deter the sordid thoughts of an e\_\_\_\_\_ man.”
- B. “Don’t let someone see what you would not want some one to t\_\_\_\_\_.”

### III. PROPER ATTITUDES

- A. The world knows: “How can you pose in a bikini and claim to be a Christian?”
- B. Some dress to be chased; but godly women are to be c\_\_\_\_\_.

- A. Would I wear this if Jesus were present?
- B. Is a *pure* heart or a *worldly* heart reflected by my dress?
