# I. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- A. **Modest:** "Well-arranged; orderly, **d**\_\_\_\_\_."
- B. **Shamefacedness:** "A sense of shame, a **r**\_\_\_\_\_ that restrains one from an unworthy act."
- C. **Sobriety** = "Soundness of mind, self-control, good judgment, moderation, as a feminine virture, decency."
- D. **Lasciviousness:** "Lustful, indecent bodily movements, unchaste handling of males and females."
- E. **Immodest Apparel**: "Any clothing that unduly reveals the **f**\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the wearer."

# II. GUIDELINES FOR MODESTY

- A. "Dress so that you will not tempt a good man and will deter the sordid thoughts of an **e**\_\_\_\_\_ man."
- B. "Don't let someone see what you would not want some one to  ${f t}$  ."
