INVITE

As we talk positively about spiritual things, we should invite others to check it out for themselves. We must make sure that those who come to check us out are warmly welcomed.

FIRST TIME GUESTS

James 2:2-4 " Suppose a man comes into your meeting wearing a gold ring and fine clothes, and a poor man in shabby clothes also comes in. 3 If you show special attention to the man wearing fine clothes and say, "Here's a good seat for you," but say to the poor man, "You stand there" or "Sit on the floor by my feet," 4 have you not discriminated among yourselves and become judges with evil thoughts?

FIRST TIME GUESTS

- "Be not forgetful to entertain strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels in unawares" (Heb 13:2).
- Abraham's reception of the heavenly messengers provides excellent lessons in how a church should treat its guests!

LESSONS FROM GEN 18: 1-8

- Demonstrate respect (vs 1-5).
- Make haste to greet guests (vs. 2).
- Make your welcome obvious (vs 2b)!
 - Receive a guest as if he were the Lord Himself (Matt 25:40)!
 - Paul "You received me as an angel of God, as Christ Jesus Himself" (Gal 4:14).

LESSONS FROM GEN 18: 1-8

- Show them favor (vs 3).
- Meet their needs/make them comfortable (vs 4-5).
- Consider a guest to be sent by God (vs).
- Involve others (vs 6-7).
- Guests should receive the best we can offer (vs 7).

LESSONS FROM GEN 18: 1-8

Stand ready to *minister* (vs 8).
Summation: "AND THEY DID EAT" (vs. 8).
If guests are received properly, they will be ready to be feed on the Word.

THE FOUR "I'S" OF A WELCOME

Identify new faces! Introduce yourself. Inquire about their interest (family, job, etc).

Show hospitality. Invite them to eat with you.
Introduce them to others.

TEN COMMANDMENTS OF AUDITORIUM MANNERS

#1: Don't hog the end of the row.
#2: Don't fight for your regular seat.
#3. Don't stare at new people.
#4. Smile and greet everyone you meet.
#5. Introduce yourself and introduce them to others.

TEN COMMANDMENTS OF AUDITORIUM MANNERS

- #6: Offer assistance (not directions).
- #7: Share your Bible or song book if no PP.
- #8. Be sensitive to the spiritual needs of the guest.
- #9. Sincerely compliment the guest.
- #10. Take time to get acquainted after services.

ARE YOU JUST A NICE COMPLACENT CHURCH MEMBER OR ARE YOU GENUINELY CONCERNED ABOUT THE SOUL OF A STRANGER??

HOW IMPORTANT ARE VISITORS?

- Churches grow primarily from "visitor flow."
 - 75% of converts come from friends and relatives of members!
- Capturing their information is critical!
 - Enables follow up and a warm greeting!
 - Provides a data base for "invitation events."
 - Provides a record for prayer!

What can we do to increase the likelihood of getting the cards filled out and returned? ENTERTAINING STRANGERS

HOW CAN WE INCREASE VISITOR FLOW?

- Jesus: "Ask and it shall be given unto you."
- Remember: "The fields are white" (John 4:35). Share the gospel first at times.
- 10% of visitors come from the marque, and it increases to 20% if it is a changeable marque.
- Use the invitation cards. Be persistent


