	1. Def: "A long series of leading questions to bring an idea to birth in the mind of the hearer."
	2. The four gospels contain over 100 q (Lk 2:46-49).
	3. He would ask questions to force a "journey within" (Jn 1:38, Lk 5: 22-23, Jn 3:12). He provoked introspection.
	4. He would ask a question with a question (Matt 21:25-27).
	F. Jesus loved the p "Truth standing on its head to get attention" (Mk 10:31, Mt 10:39, Most of the Beattitudes).
	G. He loved short pity sayings, known as "sentence sermons."
	H. He never went anywhere that he did not use p (Mk 4:33-34). Definition: "An earthly story with a heavenly meaning."
