I. NEHEMIAH NEVER FORGOT WHO HE WAS.
A. He was a faithful servant of God, a Jew, with a higher purpose in life.
B. God was looking for a man who could m over His people (1:4).
II. THREE THINGS ARE NECESSARY FOR REVIVAL AND REBUILDING.
 A. We must have people who truly care. 1. When our hearts break over the things that break the heart of God, we will do what is right. 2. The only way God can build is upon a foundation of a soft heart. B. There must be a commitment to people (Neh 1:4). 1. Nehemiah heard the news in September and decided to move forward in March, which means he spent f months in preparatory prayer. 2. Jeremiah to God: "There is nothing too h for You (Jer 32:17).
C. There must be a willingness to d and courage to do great things! III. IF WE COMMIT TO REVIVAL, TO DARE, AND TO SERIOUS VISION CASTING, IT WILL YIELD FOUR RESULTS:
A. It will yield enthusiasm and create excitement.
B. It will stimulate p
