1. Because of its p (Jn 12:32).
2. Because it demonstrates how sin is awful. (2 Cor 5:21).
B. We must not just focus on the <i>physical</i> , but on the <i>s</i> !
I. THE HISTORICAL ASPECT.
A. It was a hideous and degrading experience.
B. It was a form of p execution. The titulus stated the crime.
C. Why was Jesus dead after only s hours?
1. He had been scourged after being up all night.
2. He suffered the <i>emotional trauma</i> of bearing the g of sin.
II. THE MIRACLES OF THE CROSS.
A. Three hours of d from 12 noon until 3 p.m. (Lk 23:44).
B. The earthquake , which connotes <i>judgment</i> (<i>Matt 27: 51-52</i>).
C. The v of the temple was torn (Matt 27: 51-52).
1. A Divine act showing the Old Testament system was finished.
2. The barrier between God and man had been bridged by Jesus!
D. The t of the saints were open (Matt 27: 52)!
III. THE EVENTS SURROUNDING THE CROSS.
A. Barabbas, the g man is set free; the innocent is slain(Mk 15:15).
B. Two thieves are placed on each side of Jesus (Mark 15:27).
C. The centurion soldier declares, "Surely, this man was the son of God."
D. Jesus says: "It is finished," a Roman battle cry of victory (Jn 19:30)!
CON: No wonder Jesus said: "If I be lifted up, I will draw all men

to Myself" (Jn 12:32). Have you come to Jesus?
