 - 1. "Contend earnestly for **t**_____ faith" (Jude 3).
 - 2. Don't add to or take away (Deut 4:2, Rev 22: 18-19).
 - 3. Don't go beyond what is written (I Cor 4:6, II Jn 9).

B. We have **many examples** of the important of details.

 Argument based upon singular vs. plural (Gal 3: 16-17).
