#### IV. HE WILL OFFER A SIN-COVERING FOR YOU (Gen 3: 21-24).

- A. Adam and Eve's fig leaves were not adequate or sufficient.
- B. God knew that only substitutionary a \_\_\_\_\_ could cover sin.

#### V. HE WILL SEND HIS SON FOR YOU (Gen 3: 15, 24).

- A. Adam and Jesus share the same umbilical cord.
- B. Christ is the second A \_\_\_\_\_: the cross is the way to reverse the curse.
