#### Introduction:

- A. It is **p**\_\_\_\_\_ to be faithful in a fallen world (Matt 5: 1-16, 7: 13-14)!
- B. Seth, Enoch, and Noah were all faithful, so can we be too (Gen 4-6)!

#### I. IT IS CRUCIAL TO ADMIT WEAKNESS AND SHOW HUMILITY.

- A. Seth named his son Enosh which means “weak, sickly.”
- B. God is attracted to our admission of weakness and need (Isa 57:15).

#### II. IT IS ESSENTIAL TO CRY OUT TO GOD AND BE DEPENDENT UPON HIM.

- A. It is essential to cry out to God when the norm is to **c**\_\_\_\_\_ out God!
- B. The phrase “calling on the name of the Lord” refers to proclamation. They began to **p**\_\_\_\_\_ the nature (name) of the Lord!
- C. “Let us trust in the name of the Lord and rely upon God” (Isa 50:10).

#### III. IT IS CRITICAL TO LEAVE A SPIRITUAL LEGACY AND TO BE RESPONSIBLE.

- A. The Bible views all life as **s**\_\_\_\_\_ and all life as worship (Rom 12:1-2).
- B. The contrast between Cain’s line and Seth’s line is critical to understand:
  - 1. It is not about accomplishments, but the **p**\_\_\_\_\_ of God.
  - 2. It is not about isolation, but allowing God to dominate the world.

#### IV. IT IS VITAL TO BE FAITHFUL TO GOD AND TO BE WILLING TO SURRENDER.

- A. It is the only **h**\_\_\_\_\_ for civilization (Phil 2:12-16).
- B. We need believers in every arena of life who will secure a future for the world, and who will rescue civilization.
- C. Believers left a **l**\_\_\_\_\_ for all history. Enoch walked with God and so did his great grandson, **N**\_\_\_\_\_.
