
Go back to Egypt on the banks of the Nile River

First Plague: Water into Blood Exodus 7:20-23

And he lifted up the staff and struck the water that was in the Nile, in the sight of Pharaoh and in the sight of his servants, and all the water that was in the Nile was turned to blood. 21 The fish that were in the Nile died, and the Nile became foul, so that the Egyptians could not drink water from the Nile.



 - Lk 8:12: "Those beside the road are those who have heard; then the devil comes and takes away the word from their heart, so that they will not believe and be saved."


Felix and Paul Acts 24:25




"Yesterday is forever gone
