life-long giving?

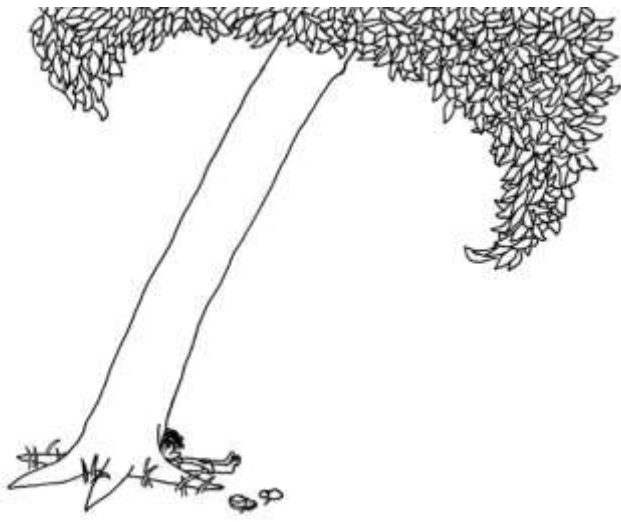
Jesus' two-level question:

Why would you do that?!

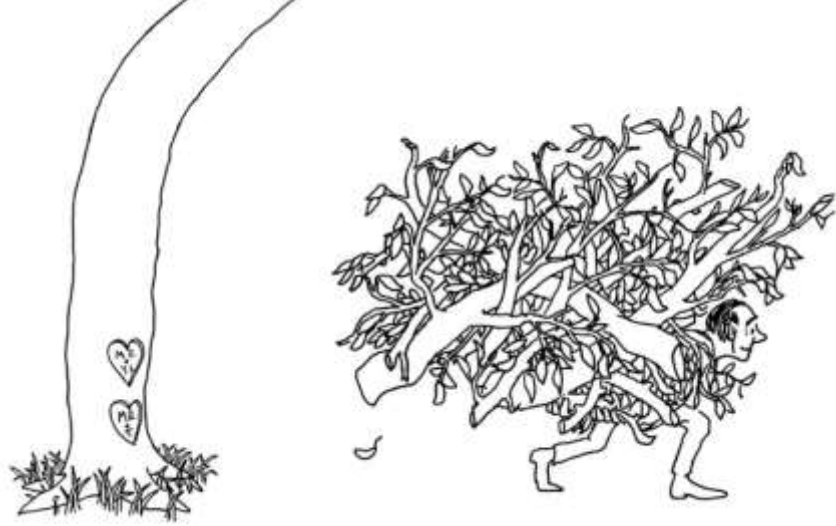
What are self-sacrificing people thinking?

- It does not make sense to give some things up.



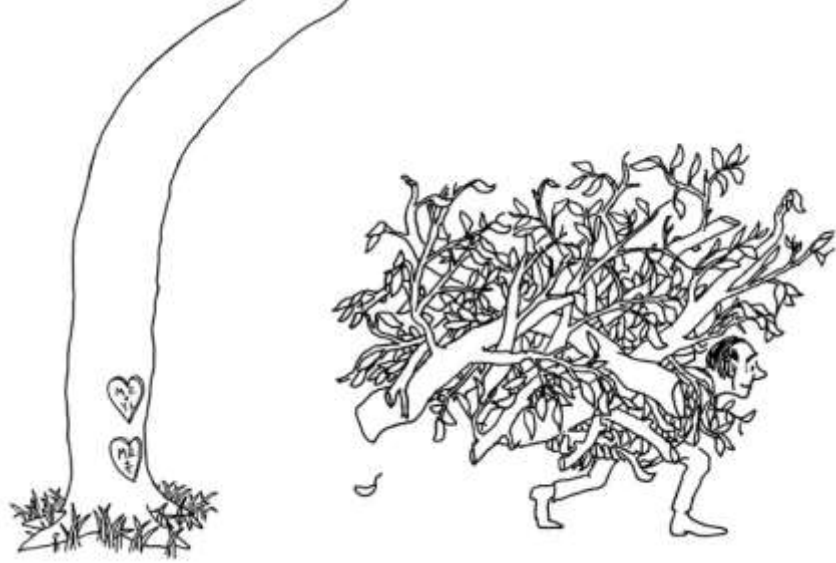
Why would you do that?!



Wives, be subject to your own husbands, so that even if some do not obey the word, they may be won without a word by the conduct of their wives, when they see your respectful and pure conduct.

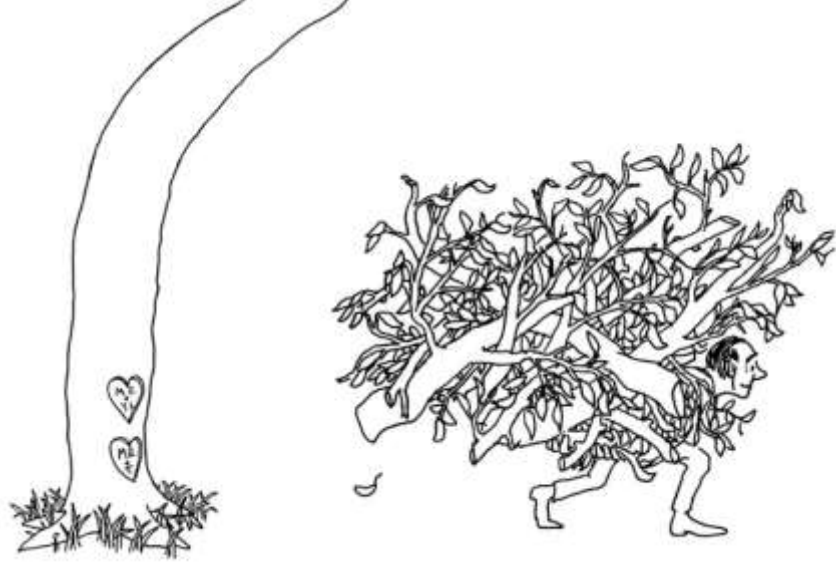

(Ephesians 5:25, 27)

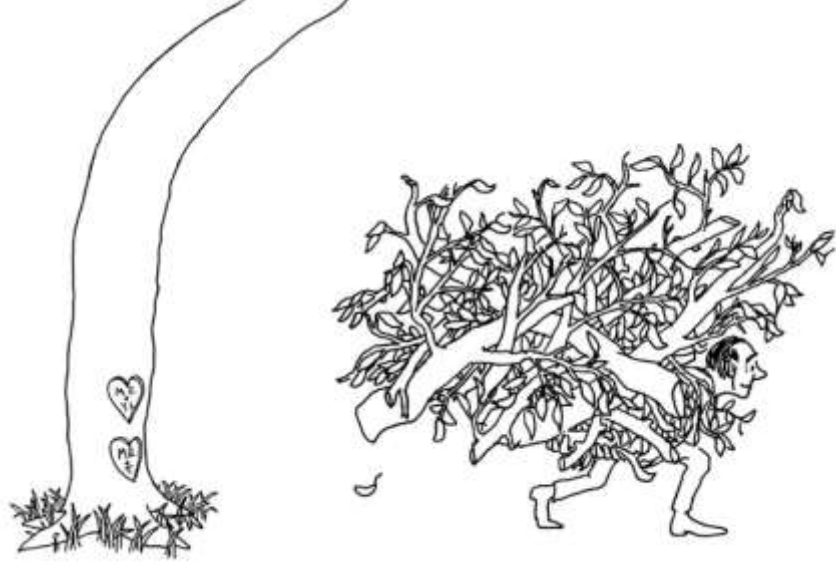
Why would you do that?!

I to be loved less?

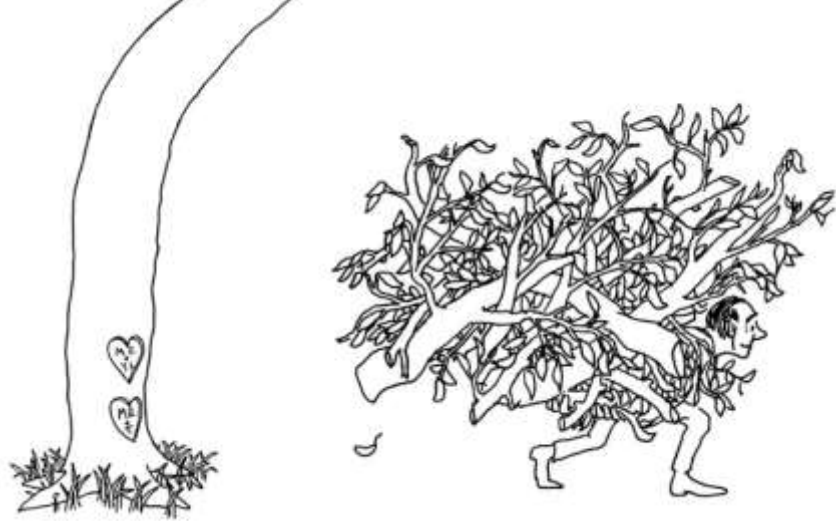

(1st Thessalonians 2:7-8)

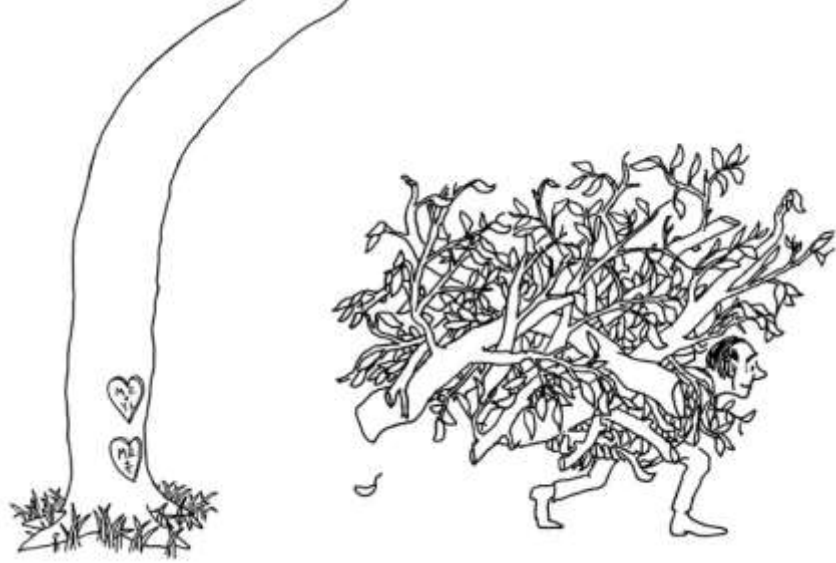


Why would you do that?!
