C. Jesus is the perfect example. "He emptied Himself" (Phil 2:7).
D. Jesus did not just give us His life on the cross, but died <b>d</b>
II. WHY WOULD SOMEONE GIVE THEIR LIFE FOR CHRIST?
A. What are self-sacrificing people thinking?
B. We often fear to give.
1. We fear it might not be <b>a</b>
2. We fear we might create dependence or "entitlement."
C. If we want to know why, we should ask those who are doing so. The committed husbands and wives, dedicated evangelists, etc.
III. HOW MUCH SHOULD WE BE WILLING TO GIVE? <b>E</b> ?
A. The widow <b>g</b> her entire living" (Luke 21: 4).
B. God commends those who give of themselves <i>generously</i> .
C. The Macedonian churches "gave beyond their means" because they first "gave themselves" (2 Cor 8: 1-5).
D. Are we willing to lay down our dreams, wealth, career plans, ideas, and life for Jesus?
