A. Twenty-seven of the thirty-six parables of Jesus deal with <i>stewardship</i> and the danger of <i>covetousness</i> .
<ul><li>B. There is more about giving in the Bible then confession,</li><li>b, and the Lord's Supper put together!</li></ul>
I. TWO KEY PREMISES:
A. One must first recognize the Creator's <b>o</b> of all things. (Ps 24:1, Ps 50:10, I Chron 29:14).
B. The surrender of self to God must <i>precede</i> the giving of our material means (2 Cor 8:5).
II. THE BIBLICAL PATTERN.
<ul> <li>A. When. "On the f day of the week" (I Cor 16:1-2).</li> <li>B. Who? "Let each one of you (I Cor 16: 1-2).</li> <li>C. How? "As he hath p and purposed" (2 Cor 9:7).</li> <li>D. How much? "Give with l (Rm 12:8).</li> <li>1. "Abound in this grace also" (2 Cor 8:7).</li> <li>2. "He who sows sparingly shall reap sparingly" (2 Cor 9:6).</li> </ul>
III. OLD TESTMENT COMPARED TO THE NEW TESTAMENT.
<ul> <li>A. In the OT they offered up "tithes and o" (Mal 3:8, 10).</li> <li>B. In the NT they offered up regular gifts to the church and had special love offerings for special needs.</li> </ul>
IV. GOD IS NOT SATISFIED WITH LEFT-OVERS (MAL 1:13).
V. WE SHOULD GIVE IN A WAY THAT IS WORSHIPFUL (MAL 1:6).
