- B. The train of His robe filled the temple = Greatness.
- C. “My eyes have seen the King!” How do we see Him?
  - 1. In the w\_\_\_\_\_ (Jn 1:1).
  - 2. In His p\_\_\_\_\_ (Jn 14:9).
  - 3. Within o\_\_\_\_\_ (Gal 2:20).

### II. CONVICTION (6:5).

- A. Become dissatisfied, humbled, undone. R\_\_\_\_\_.
- B. Discontentment leads to a\_\_\_\_\_ (Jn 3:20-21).

### III. CLEANSING (Isa 6: 6-7).

- A. “A burning coal is pressed on his l\_\_\_\_\_.”
- B. “Your iniquity is taken away and your sin is f\_\_\_\_\_”

### IV. CALLING (Isa 6:8).

- A. A calling comes only after a cleansing and understanding.
- B. Calling of Isaiah? “Go and tell His people” (vs 9).
- C. Our calling is see Him and then s\_\_\_\_\_ Him (I Peter 2:9).

### V. COMMITMENT (Isa 6:8b).

- A. Whom shall I send (vs 8)? Here am I?
- B. I v\_\_\_\_\_!
