#### Introduction:

- A. We established in part one how *important* our separateness is.
- B. Today we will focus on the following three questions.

#### I. WHAT IS OUR RELATIONSHIP TO THE WORLD?

- A. To be “in the world, but not *of* the world” (Jn 17:15-6).
- B. We must not **I**\_\_\_\_\_ the world (I Jn 2:15-17).
  - 1. “Set our affections on things above” (Col 3:2).
  - 2. We should not be shocked if the world hates us (I Jn 3:13).
- C. We must not be *conformed* to this world (Rm 12:2).
  - 1. The battle is in the mind (2 Cor 10:3-5).
  - 2. We are a *new creature* in Christ (2 Cor 5:17).
- D. We must become dead to the world (Eph 2:2).
- E. We must **r**\_\_\_\_\_ the things of the world (Eph 5:11).

#### II. HOW SHOULD WE VIEW OUR SEPARATENESS?

- A. Is separateness a punishment or a blessing?
- B. We should **e**\_\_\_\_\_ our separateness (I Peter 4:3-4).
- C. There is no benefit to looking back to **E**\_\_\_\_\_.

#### III. WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF WE FAIL TO SEPARATE?

- A. We will be found in direct conflict with the **w**\_\_\_\_\_(Lk 6:46).
- B. We shall lose our *identity* as God’s people.
- C. Our efforts at effective **e**\_\_\_\_\_ will be thwarted!

#### Conclusion:

It is time to stop *resisting* our separateness and to start *affirming* it (Rev 8:4)!
