 - 1. Leglism is not **law-keeping**.
 - 2. Legalism is **law-depending** (2 Tim 1:9).

II. WHAT GRACE IS:

- A. It is **f**_____ (Eph 1:5-6).
- B. It is rich and *lavish* (Eph 1:7-9).
- C. It is *provided* unconditionally (Rom 5:8).
- D. It serves as a great proof of God’s love (Gen 22:12).
