
The Armor of God For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.




The Armor of God Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.



The Armor of God Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness.

Background Information

The Armor of God Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.



The Armor of God And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.



The Armor of God Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.—Ephesians 6:10-1



PREPARING FOR BATTLE EPH 6: 10-13, 18

- Be strong in His strength (vs 10).
- Put on the whole armor of God (Vs 11).
- Wrestle with the hosts of evil (Vs 12).
- Do all to stand. <u>Be ready</u>. Be <u>prepared</u> (vs 13)!




Six Parts to the Armor


Helmet of Salvation

Description of Armor


- The Roman soldier's helmet was fashioned from bronze or iron.
- Two cheek-pieces
 protected the sides of the soldier's face.




Description of Armor

 For the sake of comfort, soldiers frequently lined their helmets with felt.

The Roman soldier's helmet protected his skull and neck from his enemy's weapons and falling debris.



Description of Armor +At the time of Christ, a crest with a plume of horse's hair was placed on top of Roman helmets.





Historical Background
 The purpose of the plume was to make soldiers appear taller and more imposing.



Alexander the Great Rembrandt (1655)

Protected his head from his enemy's weapons. (Ps 140:7).





Important Biblical Passages

O GOD the Lord, the strength of my salvation, thou hast <u>covered my head</u> in the day of battle.

-Psalm 140:7

Important Riblical Passages

But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for <u>an helmet, the hope of</u> <u>salvation</u>.

— 1 Thessalonians 5:8

Application

The helmet points to God's ultimate victory and the <u>blessed assurance</u> we have in Christ!
Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection provides all believers with freedom from sin.

BREASTDI ATE OE RIGHTEOUSNESS Having put on the breastplate of righteousness —Ephesians 6:14




Description of Armor

 After buckling his belt around his waist, the Roman soldier would have fastened the breastplate around his chest.

There were two types of breastplates.

The first type was fashioned by joining several broad, curved metal bands together using leather thongs.

Description of Armor + The second type of breastplate was a type of chain mail, constructed by linking small metal rings together until they formed a vest.





If a soldier failed to wear his breastplate, an arrow could easily reach a soldier's chest, piercing his **heart** or lungs.



[The LORD] put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an <u>helmet of</u> <u>salvation upon his head</u>; and he put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and will be clad with zeal as a cloak.

-Isaiah 59:17

Application

+Righteousness = "Moral uprightness, holiness, virtuousness, goodness in character and practice." Prov 4:23 "Keep our heart with all diligence."





Important Biblical Passages

Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst <u>after</u> <u>righteousness</u>: for they shall be filled. —Matthew 5:6

* "The righteous are bold as a lion" (Prov 28:1).









BELT OF TRUTH

Having your loins girt about with truth -- Ephesians 6:14 -- Prov 23:23 -- Jn 14:6



Description of Armor Leather belt with an apron that hung in front of the Roman soldier's groin and lower abdomen.

Small brass plates were attached to the apron.



The <u>first piece</u> of protective equipment . . .

Used to <u>tie up garments . . .</u>
It <u>shielded some of the most</u>

vulnerable areas of his body.





Application

+Prepares one to be ready for action.

Christians always need to be ready so they are not caught unaware!


Knowing and **sharing truth** (I Peter 3:15).

FEET PREPARED WITH THE GOSPEL OF PEACE

And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace —Ephesians 6:15



Description of Armor

Shoes were thick leather and studded through the soles with hobnails.
Slang for Roman soldiers ="boot men."



Historical Background

The studded soles enabled = to stand firm, and maintain their position.





Application

- Gk word rendered "preparation" or
 "readiness" (6:15) = <u>"prepared</u> foundation"
 a firm basis for a soldier's feet.
- Jesus Christ provides a strong foundation needed to stand firm (I Cor 3:11).
- We need to march and move forward and send the light to those in darkness!

Application

The Gospel of Peace = Peace with God.
Before conversion we were in conflict (enemies) ..but God loves us and provided reconciliation with Him = living in peace (2 Cor. 5: 18-19)!



Let us sing, Pg 572 Send the Light, vs 1, 2, 4.

SHIELD OF FAITH Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to guench all the fiery darts of the wicked. — Ephesians 6:16



Description of Armor Rectangular- four feet tall and three feet in width. The Gk word for shield means "like a door."



Description of Armor

- Two sturdy pieces of wood covered with canvas to form the core.
- ✦Goat-skin stretched tightly over the wood, the boards curved inward, and a leather strap was tacked to the shield's back.



Description of Armor Iron rims fitted along the top and bottom edges, and an iron circle was attached.

The colors of the soldier's
 military unit painted on the leather covering.



Application

- The shield of faith is the Christian's protection against temptation.
- Whenever we trust in God and know
 His will, Satan cannot tempt us with
 his lies (Ephesians 6:12)!



Historical Background Before battle, they drenched their leathercovered shields with water!



Result: the flaming
 arrows were immediately
 extinguished.



Each Soldier Depended On Each Other

Historical Background The Roman military worked together usin a formation = "the tortoise."





Application

- With true faith, "all the flaming arrows of the evil one"—every temptation can be stopped (Ephesians 6:16)!
- Authentic faith in God can overcome evil (<u>1 John 5:4</u>, 2 Sam 22:31, Ps 7:10, 18:35).





For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, <u>even our faith</u>. —1 John 5:4

Important Riblical Passages

As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all them that trust in him.

-2 Samuel 22:31

My defence is of God, which saveth the upright in heart. —Psalm 7:10

SWORD OF THE SPIRIT

Take ... the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God —Ephesians 6:17



Description of Armor

- +About two feet long, crafted from iron.
- Blacksmiths hardened the blade by covering the red-hot iron with coal dust.
- Sword handles could be iron, ivory, bone, or wood.



For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. —Hebrews 4:12

Historical Background

+Carried his sword on his right side, so that he could easily draw his sword in a close-knit row of troops.





Historical Background

In battle, soldiers pressed back their enemies one step at a time by forcing their shields forward, using their swords and shields to advance against the enemy.



Application

The only offensive weapon mentioned in Ephesians 6 is the sword!

+This is how we spread the gospel!



Application

- The "word of God" = the Scriptures. + Jesus used the Bible to answer and the devil left him (M
- + 10% of everything Jesus said were OT quotations of scripture.




