#### Introduction:

“Adorn yourself in *modest* apparel” (I Tim 2:9).

#### I. KEYS TO REMEMBER ABOUT MODESTY

- A. “Dress so that you will not tempt a good man and will deter the sordid thoughts of an evil man.”
- B. “Don’t let a man see what you would not want him to touch.”
- C. “God wants us to love people and use things”
- D. “Let each man please his neighbor, for his good, for his e\_\_\_\_\_” (Rom 15:2).

#### II. WHAT ABOUT BEING A TRANSVESTITE?

- A. The woman shall not wear that which pertains unto a man.
- B. Neither shall a man put on a woman’s g\_\_\_\_\_” (Deut 22:5).

#### III. WHAT ROLE DOES FASHION AND CULTURE PLAY?

- A. The head-covering or veil was a c\_\_\_\_\_ (I Cor 11:15-16).
- B. Culture affects our influence, but does not set the standard.

#### IV. IS THERE AN ABSOLUTE STANDARD?

- A. Adam and Eve were given coats of skin, and God c\_\_\_\_\_ them (Gen 3:21). Lit: “A garment which drapes down over the shoulders and approaches the knee.”
- B. The priests were to wear linen breeches to cover their flesh. They shall reach from the w\_\_\_\_\_ even to the thighs” (Ex 28:42).

#### Conclusion:

May we clothe ourselves so that the “s\_\_\_\_\_ of our nakedness will not be manifest” (Rev 3:18).
