#### **Introduction:**

- A. Difficulties and trouble are a part of life (Jn 16:33).
- B. There are three keys to dealing with difficulties.

#### I. DETERMINE THE REASON FOR THE DIFFICULITY.

- A. David did not receive the insight he needed until he went into the the house of God to  $\mathbf{w}_{----}$  (Ps 73:16).
- B. Three common mistakes are illustrated for us from Acts 27.
  - 1. We listen to bad advice (Acts 27:11).
  - 2. We follow the **c**\_\_\_\_\_\_ (Acts 27: 12).
  - 3. We rely on circumstances (Acts 27:13).

#### II. DETERMINE THE RESULT. What am I to learn from this?

- A. Regardless of the source, God has a purpose for every problem.
- B. The problem is temporary but the purpose is **p**\_\_\_\_\_\_ (2 Cor 4:17).
- C. God can use every difficulty for our development.

#### III. DETERMINE MY RESPONSE. How Should I react?

- A. What happens to me is not as important as *how* I respond to it.
- B. We find illustrated for us from Acts 27 *three wrong responses:* 
  - 1. Difficulties can cause us to **d**\_\_\_\_\_(Acts 27:15).
  - 2. Difficulties can cause us to discard (Acts 27: 18).
  - 3. Difficulties can cause us to dispair (Acts 27: 20).
- C. What is the *right response* to difficulties?
  - 1. Confess my part (Proverbs 28:13).
  - 2. Confront the problem (Acts 27:34-40).
  - 3. Claim God's promises (Acts 27:25),

Prove your discipleship by handling difficulties with patience!
